The **Pet Obedience Class** is \$25 for a single visit, \$180 for an 8 visit package or \$240 for a 12 visit package. This is a progressive, level based class that allows for missed classes with no information being missed.

The **Breed Handling Class** is \$10 for a single visit or \$40 for a 5 visit package

All **Advanced Classes\*** are \$40 for a single visit or \$300 for a package of 8 visits.

All Advanced Classes, except the Therapy Dog Class, are taught on a progressive schedule allowing you to miss without missing information.

### Therapy Dog Class

This is a 7 week course. If you have purchased an 8 week package, your 8<sup>th</sup> session can be used for your registration testing.

### Testing and Certification

**CGC Testing** is held at 3:00pm the first Saturday of every month.

Testing is \$30 and the optional **CGC Preparation Class** held prior to the test at 2:00pm is \$25.

We offer **Therapy Dog Registration Test** through **Pet Partners** four times a year. This test is proctored by **Dr. Christina Strayer of Animal-Assisted Therapy of the Triangle**. For those not using a package, the cost of Certification is \$40. Please be aware that Pet Partners requires you to pass their online Pet Partners Handler Course prior to testing with your animal.

**Classes are not held on, or near, Holidays. Please call to verify if your class is meeting at these times.**

## Group Classes Descriptions

### **Pet Obedience Class**

We offer four levels of progressive obedience classes starting with a free training orientation. In this format we will take you and your dog from basic through intermediate obedience training at your own pace.

For your convenience we offer the classes during the day on Saturdays, as well as Tuesday & Thursday evenings. If you can't make it every week, that's okay! Classes are designed to allow you to miss when needed and not fall behind. You can enroll at any time, come when you can and graduate when ready.

### **Therapy Class**

This class is designed to prepare you and your dog for everything you will encounter, not only during your evaluation to become a Registered Therapy Dog Team, but also while out working as a team to provide therapy to those who need it.

*Dogs must be at least 1 year of age and be able to demonstrate basic obedience skills. If your dog has received a CGC certification within the last year, this will be sufficient proof that your dog has an understanding of the basic obedience skills needed. Otherwise a basic obedience assessment will need to be conducted by one of our trainers.*

### **Scent Detection Class**

There are so many uses for scent detection training including lifesaving skills such as detecting blood glucose levels, alerting to seizures or migraines, or for the fun of competing in Nosework or AKC Scent competitions.

*There are no prerequisites for this class other than attending a private Consult or a group Orientation.*

### **Competitive Obedience**

Have you ever thought about competing with your dog? There are a lot of sports you can do with your dog and many include competitive level obedience. If you have ever thought about competing in AKC Obedience, AKC Rally, Schutzhund or PSA, join us!

*Dog owners must have completed a Consult or attended a Group Orientation to begin this class. The class Instructor may recommend for you to attend our Pet Obedience Class before joining the Competitive Obedience Class.*

### **Protection Class**

Dogs of all ages and experience levels are welcome. We offer training at every level and multiple styles. From sport dogs, to personal protection and law enforcement, from drive building with rags and tugs, to complex scenarios in full bite suits, we offer it all. Let us show you what your dog is capable of!

*A Private Consult with the class instructor is required to join this class. The instructor of this class reserves the right to ask any person to leave the class if the dog does not maintain the level of obedience required.*

### **Breed Handling Class**

If you have ever wished to show your dog in the conformation ring, this is the class for you! Here you will learn proper stacking techniques and ring etiquette from experienced conformation Handlers.

*There are no prerequisites for this class.*
